

Participation Requirements

The Staunton Arts Council does not require a commission on sales. Artists are responsible for collecting and reporting Illinois State Tax (forms provided).

Artists are required to be present with their work during festival hours.

The Staunton Art Festival is a rain or shine show.

The Staunton Art Festival is not responsible for damaged goods and is not reliable for any personal property damage or theft during the fair.

Individual display areas are approximately 10x10. Artists are responsible for their own display and lighting equipment which must conform to space allotments.

Unframed, signed/unsigned reproductions may be sold, but will be displayed in portfolios (not on screens) and clearly labeled as reproductions. Note cards, calendars, books and other items created from the artist's own work may be offered. Mechanically reproduced art should be limited to no more than 50% of total display.

All work offered must be original by the exhibiting artist. No kits or work from kits are acceptable. Plagiarism, production line art or art factory reproduced items (other than noted above) are grounds for immediate removal from the show.
